EXHIBITOR INFORMATION – SHOW STATEMENT:

Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following terms and conditions: None of the IASPHA Series Shows, IASPHA, or its officers and directors, the owner of the facility, the show manager, or any employee, independent contractor or volunteer of the show shall in any way, jointly or individually, be responsible for, or have any liability for, any loss, accident, damage or loss, including loss of life, that may occur to any person, including any exhibitor, owner, trainer, agent, groom, stable, animal, spectator, any property or equipment, sustained at, or as a result of, the IASPHA Show Series Horse Shows held at the facility in Woodstock, IL. All horses must be kept under control and, if they are not, they may be barred from competition and entry fees forfeited at the discretion of the show management. Show management reserves the right to change officials at any time and to refuse entries of any exhibitor not in good standing with IASPHA, ESC, IHPBEA, ASAW or MAHSA. The judge's decision is FINAL. All classes will be run under current IASPHA/Chapter 10 Academy Rules. If not covered by IASPHA, current ESC rules will be followed.

ADMISSION OF HORSES

Horses will be admitted no earlier than 12:00 noon on Friday
Warm Up Ring and arena will be available for use Friday.

WINTER WARM UP T-SHIRT REQUIRED ATTIRE

The attire for the competition is the Winter Warm Up T-Shirt, jods and jod boots. Please specify t-shirt size on the entry blank. No riding suits or academy outfits will be allowed.

PARKING

Trailers must be parked in approved trailer locations. Campers must be parked in approved camping locations only.

BEDDING

No first bedding will be provided per stall. Shavings will be available at \$13 per bag from the show office. NO STRAW BEDDING OR OUTSIDE BEDDING ALLOWED. All bedding must be purchased from Beyond Stable Farm (3 bag minimum).

STABLING

All stalls are 10' x 10' with tongue and groove solid wood on three sides. **Please note the facility prohibits putting screws or nails into the wood.** Staples are acceptable. The floor is concrete.

CAMPING

RV Parking spots are available for \$30 per night. This includes 30-amp electrical hookup. Please reserve on entry form.

WARM-UP RING SAFETY REGULATIONS

To ensure the safest possible event, only participants (riders/drivers, trainers and grooms) are permitted in the warm-up area, preferably, one class before they compete. Be courteous to novice or young riders, be mindful when changing directions, enter quietly, and avoid blocking the gates. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. If you see a rider, handler, trainer, or anyone else violating the welfare of a horse or rider, report it to management. We want to create a safe, positive, and fun atmosphere for all to enjoy, and continue to set a good example to all who are watching. Appropriate warm up ring etiquette will be enforced.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All horses shipped into the State of Illinois must have the required health certificates issued by a veterinarian from the state or region. Negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia required for each horse within the prior 12 months. All horses on the show grounds must be in good health. Animals showing evidence of contagious or infectious diseases will be removed from the grounds at management or facility discretion.

ENTRIES

Entries close January 26. All stall and office fees must be paid for and postmarked by January 25 to avoid the post entry fee. The show committee reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entrance fee. This committee may prohibit any one from attending or showing a horse. It also may remove any owner, stable employee, or horse from the ring or grounds without liability.

POST ENTRY FEES

There will be a post entry fee of \$10 per horse on entries postmarked after the show entry closing date.

REFUNDS

No refunds, except for a veterinarian's certificate of unfitness. Only class fees will be refunded. No refunds on stalls ordered.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE TAB

All exhibitors must leave a blank, signed check in the show office before receiving numbers. All checks returned by the bank and having to be resubmitted will be subject to a \$50 fee charged by IASPHA.

DOGS

Dogs must be confined or on a leash. Owner assumes all liability for their dog. Due to safety and liability concerns, all pets in the stabling area must be leashed or contained at all times and crated or contained in a stall/tack room during the horse show performances. Animals may not block passage in aisle-ways at any time

TWO MINUTE GATE RULE

A two-minute gate rule will be enforced. Notify the horse show office in cases where a gate hold in excess of two minutes is required.

SPLITS AND CANCELLATIONS

Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes due to the number of entries per class. Management reserves the right to split any class when safety is a concern.

EQUIPMENT

Horses must have a flat English type saddle in all saddle seat classes. Horses used in hunt seat or western classes must wear the appropriate saddles for those classes. Horses may wear any type of bridle. Any rider 10/Under must wear protective head gear. No braiding of manes, or blacking of feet. Tails can be up or down. Wraps, splint boots and bell boots are permitted.

RIDERS

The rider's age as of December 1st 2025 will be the age group said rider will compete in throughout shows for that season. Riders cannot show walk/trot and walk/trot/canter at the same tournament.

If entries are being completed on Horse Shows Online, please enter each rider separately (on their own entry form). A horse may be entered multiple times, and this will ensure each rider will have their own back number.

ACADEMY HORSES

Academy classes are open to any rider presently enrolled in a professionally operated riding lesson program. Riders must be mounted on school horses. Horses in academy classes may be owned by anyone but they cannot be in training and they MUST currently earn their living in a lesson program. Riders may show their own horses in academy provided the horse is regularly used in a professional lesson program. Academy horses may be shown by non-academy riders in any other classes in the show for which they are eligible. The age of riders is as of December 1. All academy riders must be entered by the entry date deadline so splits may be determined if necessary.

SHOW HORSES

Show horses may show in show practice classes, open training/open classes and new horse/new rider classes only.

RIBBONS/TROPHIES

Trophy for first place. Ribbons will be awarded 1-8 place.

HOSPITALITY

There will not be a food truck on the grounds. Complimentary donuts, snacks, water, pop and lunch will be provided by IASPHA during the show outside the horse show office. Barns are welcome to provide their own hospitality in the stabling area.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

OPEN TRAINING CLASSES

Open to all horses and disciplines. To be shown under saddle at a walk, trot and canter. Snaffle bridle is optional. Open to professionals and amateurs.

SHOW PRACTICE CLASSES

Open to show and academy horses. Judged on the ability to present the horse to the best advantage. Good class for riders needing experience between show seasons or introduce a beginner show rider to the art of showing.

NEW HORSE/NEW RIDER CLASS

Designed for a first or second time team of horse and rider. Should be used for show riders and show horses, but not limited to show horses. Full bridles are strongly suggested.

SHOW RIDER/ACADEMY HORSE CLASS

Class is designed for show riders to get more practice showing on academy horses. No show horses allowed in this class.

ACADEMY WALK/TROT CLASSES

Academy riders only. Open to riders that have not cantered at a show.

SCHOOL HORSE ACADEMY CLASSES

School horses should be farm owned, barefoot or simply shod, older type horse or open breed horse with a lesser head carriage, and excessive motion or headset will be penalized.

ACADEMY PLEASURE/SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

No show horses. Will be judged 50 % on basic riding skills, and 50% on basic showmanship skills. Rider's ability to show the horse is paramount.

ADVANCED LEADLINE WALK AND TROT

Riders will be led in at a walk and worked each way of the ring. The riders will be individually trotted past the judge. Riders are expected to post, but correct diagonals are not required. Class will be judged.

NOVICE RIDER

Open to riders that have not won three classes in their respective division (Walk/Trot and Walk/Trot/Canter).

PATTERN CLASSES

Pattern classes are open to all riders and academy or show horses. Pattern will be posted in the office. No rail work.
